The applicants submit (Upload) work produced during the assignments, their portfolio, and other application materials (see above).

<u>Interview:</u> Personal interviews with the admission jury take place optionally in presence or via video conference. Applicants who are accepted to the interview will be receiving a personal invitation via eMail.

<u>Online registration</u>: Please fill in the online registration form. You will receive an eMail of confirmation with your registration number and a personalized link for data upload.

<u>Documents and certificates:</u> Please upload all necessary documents and certificates in one PDF. Each file has to include your name and registration number. All documents can be uploaded <u>after</u> registration. (max. 300MB)

<u>The portfolio</u> is a collection of work samples demonstrating effectively the applicant's interest in architecture, space, material, textures, use/appropriations, form, light.... This can be shown by using different kind of media: e.g. drawings, sketches, plans, photos, critical writings, scripts, animation, or sound. Digital media should be additionally described on paper through image and text.

All works have to be handed in in digital format.

Please hand in (Upload) your portfolio in one PDF document (max. 300MB), if technically not possible also various documents and images are allowed. Videos should be included as links, possibly with password (Cloud, Homepage or Vimeo, YouTube). Each file has to include your name and registration number. All documents and works of exercise can be uploaded <u>after</u> registration.

<u>Portfolio reviews:</u> To give you the opportunity to show your work and to talk with teachers for support and advice we offer regular <u>portfolio reviews</u> from April 2023 on. <u>Admission to study</u>: After successfully passing the admission test, you must register in person at the registrar's office (study department) with all required documents.
