# CALL FÜGERPRIZE

### In the study year 2020/21 the Fügerprize in the amount of € 1.000 will be awarded

Donated in 1819 in memory of Heinrich Friedrich Füger, professor and then director of the Academy of Fine Arts Vienna (1751-1818), this prize is awarded annually to students by the *'Preisjury'*. The jury consists of representatives from all fields of study (nominated by the heads of department) and two external members (nominated by the Senate). This award is intended to honor Füger's major concern that drawing should play a central role in artistic education.

### **Requirements for application:**

- Students of all artistic fields of study are entitled to submit works.
- The works must be hand drawings (without exception) and must not exceed the format 1m x 1m. (Note: only one work per applicant no cyclical work; painterly works on paper are also not permitted).
- If sketchbooks are submitted, it must be clear which side (left or right) is meant.

The **applicants** have to **register** at the office of the respective institute. The exact deadline for registration will be posted at the respective institute. A list of the applicants must be sent by the office managers to the Registrar's office by <u>Monday</u>, June 14, 2021 at the latest.

The works have to be submitted by the students on **Thursday**, **June 17**, **2021 between 9:00am and 11:00am** (according to the list of applicants) at the *Mehrzwecksaal/Atelierhaus* - **1060 Vienna**, **Lehargasse 6 – handing them over to Mr. Franz Wibmer.** No works can be submitted later. The submitted drawing must be labelled with the name on the back. The student card must be presented when submitting the work.

The drawings must be picked up again at the *Mehrzwecksaal* after the jury meeting on Thursday, June 17, 2021, between 2pm and 3pm. The student card has to be shown again. The Academy of Fine Arts Vienna assumes no liability for the submitted works.
