Remake of Mierle Laderman Ukeles "Maintenance Art Performance Series" 1973-1974 - the part where she is washing the floor in a museum.


I agreed with the Danish comtemporary art gallery "Mogadishni" to carry out this project. The concept was to clean the whole gallery (incl. storage, kitchen ect.) while simutaneously videotaping the process. Six kameras recorded from different ponit of views the rooms - almost covering all spaces in the gallery.


In the video installeation each kamera has got its own monitor. The monitors are showing me entering and leaving the different rooms while repeatedly cleaning.

Ukeles finished her performance by throwing the washwater down the stairs indicating the posibility of change. On contrary I remake the cleaning thirty years after by repeating the cleaning forever (loop). Not much happened since then and the video does not offer much hope for changes in the future.


















"Buzz"2008. site-specific installation at "Jens Nielsen og Olivia Holm-Møller Museet" in Holstebro, Denmark.

At the museum their is a weak buzz sound emitting from the heating system. The system consists of a ventilaton shaft, a motor and a heater. Since the sound is very enoying I decided to use it in my artwork by making the ventilation system visible.

The work consists of two parts:

In the first part I am making the shaft visible, The shaft is inside the main wall in the exhibition space. The placement of a handmade ladder allows the viewer to look down the shaft.
